Even music evolving from a background like this finds its place in an historical development, although music history hasn't been densely inhabited by musicians and composers who are working towards a productive tension between the poles of improvisation and composition. And the selection becomes even more narrow when restricting the search onto groups of musicians who, in more heroic times, were quick to be named a "collective." Between the pitfalls of simple juxtaposition, well-meant layering, and structureless over-expression only a small range of music was able to outgrow its temporal justification. *Christian Scheib*
